Comprehensive Plan Amendment to Capital Facilities Chapter/Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan to Facilitate Updates to Residential Open Space Requirements

Name: Comprehensive Plan Amendment to Capital Facilities Chapter/Parks, Recreation and Open Space

Plan to Facilitate Updates to Residential Open Space Requirements

Description: The City of Federal Way Planning Division proposes an amendment to the Federal Way Parks,

Recreation and Open Space (PROS) Plan, which is incorporated by reference as part of the Capital Facilities chapter of the comprehensive plan, to facilitate an update to the method for calculating open space for residential subdivisions. The PROS Plan amendment removes one sentence which refers to residential subdivisions being required to provide open space for 15 percent of the gross land area of the subdivision. A related code amendment is updating the method of calculating residential open space for single-family subdivisions from a percent of gross land area basis to a square foot per unit basis. The change to the method for calculating residential subdivision open

space is only possible with this PROS Plan amendment.
