DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Code Amendments for Development Agreements

Description: The proposed code amendments to FWRC 19.85 Development Agreements are intended to improve the clarity of what can be included in a development agreement; clarify when a development agreement may be processed; and, remove certain Sections that should not be part of City Code.

The City's Responsible Official has determined that the proposal does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment, and an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is not required under Revised Code of Washington 43.21C.030(2)(c). This DNS is issued under Washington Administrative Code 197-11-340(2). The lead agency will not act on this proposal for 14 days from the date of issuance. Comments must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. on 18 August 2023. Unless modified by the city, this determination will become final following the comment deadline. Any person aggrieved by the city's determination may file an appeal with the city within 21 days of the above comment deadline. You may appeal this determination to the Federal Way City Clerk (address above), no later than 5:00 p.m. on 8 September 2023, by a written letter stating the reason for the appeal of the determination. You should be prepared to make specific factual objections.
